During December, educators will introduce the themes of "Winter" and the "Holiday Season" to promote scientific inquiry and problem-solving skills among children. Through exploration of winter animals, their habitats, and behaviors, students will be encouraged to observe, make predictions, pose questions, and seek answers. Teachers will also design and implement developmentally appropriate arts and crafts activities, as well as introduce the letters Gg, Hh, Ii, and the numbers 13, 14, 15, and 16. For the social-emotional curriculum, children will learn about healthy habits, personal care, and how to utilize their senses throughout the holiday season.
